

PYSA FALL 2020 COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES

Each player and coach must check for symptoms associated with COVID-19 prior to all practices and games, and need to stay home if they exhibit ANY symptoms. Symptoms may include fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue or body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, as well as other symptoms that may be associated with COVID-19 according to the CDC.

All coaches, spectators and officials must wear facial coverings at all times. Players must wear a mask to and from practices and games, but can remove them when on the playing field.

All players, coaches and spectators must maintain six feet social distancing, except players when they are on the field of play.

Players may not share any equipment such as pinnies, water bottles, etc. PYSA coaches will not be organizing or encouraging group snacks after games. If snacks are desired, players' families are responsible for their own snacks - please don't share.

All pinnies must be washed in between practices and games after use, and any shared equipment needs to be sanitized.

Coaches should set up six feet social distancing stations for players to put their equipment and water bottles, and to take water breaks at.

All players and coaches should avoid additional contact such as high fives, handshakes, etc. When players are huddled during coach communication with the team, please maintain spacing and social distancing at all times.

If a player or coach is tested for Covid-19, that player may not participate in practice or games until the results are received.

If a family member, close friend, or classmate of a PYSA participant tests positive for Covid-19 with whom there has been recent contact, then the parent of the player must notify PYSA staff immediately.

Any player or coach that tests positive for Covid-19 may not participate in any practices or games for a minimum of 14 days after the positive test and must notify PYSA staff immediately.

In the event of a positive test, the team associated with the player or coach may not participate in any practices or games for 10 days. October 24th is set as a makeup date and no games will be made up after that date.
